Carmarthen and District Harriers Committee Meeting – Ivy Bush Hotel – Carmarthen Wednesday 24th May 2017

Hedydd welcomed Kathryn to her first meeting.

The minutes of meeting held on 4th April 2017 were accepted as a true record.

Minutes arising from the meeting

- Harriers Dinner: The date for the 3rd November was first in doubt due to booking clashes however this is now not a problem and the dinner will go ahead on the original date at the Ivy Bush. Lyn Davies, Colin Jackson, Jamie Baulch, Rhys Williams have been guest speakers over the years and the 2017 speaker will be local GB athlete Dewi Griffiths. It was felt that this was a good choice as Dewi trains regularly at the track and the young athletes will be inspired.
- Thursday evening training is increasing with about 12 junior members attending weekly. These have been introduced as a progression group from busy Tuesday evenings and are only open to those competitive athletes, not for anyone.
- The track condition was reported better than 20 years ago however it can become a problem at times. Jake has been in contact with several personnel to get things sorted. The signs seem that the track will be refurbished in 2 years and currently looking at costs. The sector lines have been re-done several times but in the incorrect markings. A temporary line had to be put in by the match referees at the two of the recent meetings. High Jump stands have been ordered, but the HJ bed and Pole Vault stands are not working correctly. Leisure Centre staff continue to be reminded about rubbish that is left following competitions.
- Membership numbers are growing but still unregistered athletes train on a Tuesday evening, especially in the 6-7 sprints and field groups. New vests have been ordered by Hedydd.
- Dyfed Network Officer job: the job has been vacant since the middle of July however the job was advertised and interviews have been taking place.
- Officials have improved this year compared to past years with more parents getting involved thanks to Alison for getting them all together.

- Primary Schools Cross Country at the Showground is being looked into how to accommodate the number that attends these popular events as car parking was a problem back in March.
- The Gwent League AGM is on 2nd June at Bridgend. It was agreed that Pembrey Country Park will be proposed once again following last winter's success with it being asked as a venue for the West Wales Championships. The first staging saw enough volunteers and positive feedback from competitors and spectators. Pembrey would be a great venue for a three year cycle of the Welsh Cross Country Championships which has gone to Swansea. Other events to bear in mind include the Road Relays this September and Welsh Trail Championships, if events are well organized athletes will come back to scenic views such as Llanelli.

Financial Report

Current Account £47,757.65

Income includes Membership fees, Bus Fares, Sale of Vests, Grants and Training Levy. There have been much sponsorship given to the club throughout the years and these include grants or sponsorship from Ffoshelig, Welsh Athletics, McDonalds, West Wales Freemasons, Tovali and the Carmarthen Accident Repair Centre

Expenditure includes Equipment, Medals, WA Registration fees, Vests and Hire of Buses. Expenditure also comes from hiring the sportshall and track for training evenings along with booking the competition venues.

West Wales championships in Carmarthen on Sunday 14 May 2017

Championships was this year much better supported by Carmarthen Harriers athletes

A total of 40 medals (16 gold, 14 silver and 10 bronze) won this year

Catering

This year we have lost a lot of income from the Brianne and Ceredigion schools championships held in Carmarthen on 10 and 11 May 2017

Athletics Track and Carmarthen Leisure Centre

Unlike other Athletics there is hardly any maintenance done on the track during the winter months

However the Track is now slightly better maintained in the summer months thanks the efforts of Sarah Jones, one of the Carmarthen Leisure Centre duty officers who has responsibility for the Athletics Track

Rubbish at the Track has been and always is a problem. Leisure Centre staff are continuously reminded to clean up after major events

Track Bookings

Events at the Track are booked in January every year. Not yet had the invoices from Carmarthenshire County Council

Carmarthen Harriers pay all the invoices and then claim back from other event users (Louise Arthur, West Wales and Dyfed Schools)

St John's Ambulance

A good service provided by St John's. Bookings now have to go through the Dyfed organiser and not the local headquarters. Invoices are received in November every year. Costs are likely to be much higher this year

Brianne and Ceredigion schools athletics championships

As indicated before we are not providing refreshments for the athletes on the day of their championships in Carmarthen. Track is in quite a state after their events

Dyfed schools championships on Friday evening 9 June and Saturday 10 June 2017

This once again clashes with the Welsh senior athletics championships in Cardiff. This year only 3 Dyfed athletes have entered the Welsh senior championships. Dyfed for a very long time have held their championships on the Friday evening and Saturday evening the week after the summer half term

Examinations and Dyfed having four area championships is the reason why the Dyfed championships are held in June every year (Cardiff this year held their senior championships this year on 25 April and ANT on 7 May 2017)

Catering

It will be a very busy day and Edward will need as much help as possible from Harriers members. Dyfed PE teacher officials will receive refreshments this year (courtesy of the West Wales Freemasons grant to Carmarthen Harriers)
