The minutes of meeting held on 9th January 2017 were accepted as a true record.

Minutes arising from the meeting

- Welsh Athletics / Carmarthen Town Awards 2017 Number of Harriers members involved a few months back and winning / runners up. Nominations from other sporting clubs, especially the Carmarthen Town Awards were very poor.
- The portacabin cost over £6,000 to repair and a £2,000 grant was approved By Carmarthenshire County Council.
- Harriers Dinner 2017: The first date of 3rd November might change for this year's dinner and the end of October was suggested or the 13th (Ivy Bush will be contacted over suitable dates away from half term)
- Transport continues to be provided to all the matches and was used rather well during the cross country season. Money was saved by not taking buses to the Singleton Park and Pembrey fixtures.
- Hire of track: Training fee continues to come in well on Tuesday
 Evenings from the track and sportshall, Thursdays can still be an issue
 with the older athletes while there are no issues with the younger
 group.
- The track does need relining and will probably take place after the track season has been completed this year. Dave Jessett will be asked to come and inspect the track as has been done over the last few years. It was reported that one of the steeplechase barrier was rotten and the High Jump/Pole Vault beds were not in the best condition. Hedydd was meeting the Leisure Centre manager to discuss the year's activities.
- Membership forms are still slowly coming in, despite the year starting on 28th February. All athletes should be reminded that they are not insured and therefore coaches shouldn't be coaching them. Coaches should also take responsibility for the issue and check they are all members before starting. Lists of full members are available online for coaches and team managers. With safeguarding in mind, all information of athletes are kept confidential by coaches/TM.

Memorial Carmarthen Throws Fixtures

It was agreed that the first Carmarthen Harriers Throws meeting on 27 April 2017 would be called the Richard Wyer Memorial Throws meeting and the third one on 29 June 2017 to be known as the Ossie Morgan Memorial Throws competition

Also agreed this year is that two disciplines will take place on the evening (3 events was too much for the short number of officials with the event going on late) Javelin as the most popular event will be included in all four meetings with Discus, Shot and Hammer alternating.

There is a field assistant course taking place in Llanelli on 22nd April with another on 29th May. The matches include the Louise Arthur and Welsh Senior League.

It was brought up that those who give up their time should be recognized (Team Managers, Coaches, Officials) from the club by having a T-Shirt/Top while at the events to show that they are important and they know who's who and value all members (free packed lunch, free travel on buses just a few ways of saying thank you)

Jumpers to team managers were discussed a few years back, on that occasion it was passed however Neil and Alison will be looking into this. Parents need to be encouraged from U11 up and a good way of contributing towards the success.

<u>Coaching</u>: Jane has reported that there has been improvement with some parents prepared to support the coaching team on a Tuesday. With the summer quickly approaching, it was agreed that a sub coaching committee needs to be held soon to discuss a few things including decision making which will be brought back to future committee meetings.

There was no latest coaching report; however the number attending each week is good and choice of groups available. Alan on the throws sees an increase on athletes interested in doing the shot or discus.

Any other Business

- Gwent League at Pembrey on 4th March: the day was a hailed as a great success. Welsh Athletics were also impressed with the arrangements and venue and it is hoped that they will agree on putting on a series of events in Pembrey including the Road Relays in September, the Welsh Cross Country Championships in the future and/or SIAB International & Home Countries in 2021. There were many Carmarthen Harriers volunteers involved and turned out to be great teamwork. Pembrey was put back on the map in West Wales as a venue.
- Cressy Morgan was thanked for selling the raffle tickets received from Carmarthen Town AFC which was sold to parents and members (big prizes on offer)
- Notice Board outside the track: The windows are still locked and some information not updated. It was agreed by the entrance that the board needs a brighter look that will attract people as they enter the Leisure Centre. The Harriers do have a publicity board inside the Leisure Centre however this is situated right at the back where no one passes, Leisure Centre manager will be approached to move closer to the new and current entrance.
- Australian Athletics Tour 2017: Neville Sillitoe, the Team Manager has already been in contact over the summer arrangements. Some concern has been raised over his wellbeing as he now cannot walk, however six athletes will be coming over along with an assistant. They will stay on June 9th-11th in the Ivy Bush.
- Following on from the last meeting where description of each job role within a club was discussed, Neil reported he had a list of all the roles with hyperlinks in addition, he will e-mail these around.
- Alfie Pics (Garry Smith) is involved with the club in taking photographs at events. Dyfed Secondary Schools, Gwent League and Dyfed Primary Schools are just some of the events this year so far.
- There is still no sign of Welsh Athletics recruiting a new Dyfed Network Officer, this post has been empty since the end of January.
- The portacabin has a wall of international athletes over the years and athletes are reminded to send in their photograph that they can be included on the walls.
- Annual Dinner 2017: Rhian Glynn has asked all those in 2017 to ensure that attendees include on their forms: who they'd like to be seated to, name and age group, dietery requirements and a printed mobile / e-mail address.

<u>Dyfed Primary Schools Cross Country Championships – 16/03/17</u>

Very big turnout at the Showground a few weeks back with a total of 1,453 runners. Cegin Fach Y Wlad and Cambrian Ice Cream provided the refreshments and donated to the club. (they seemed to be in the wrong place on the day and as a first time, this can be improved) Hedydd said that he will be meeting the car park marshals to discuss whether there's anything that can be done to minimize traffic disruption entering of the A40, traffic went back to the B&Q roundabout. There was a discussion over car park charges of £1 however the outcome was to increase the entry fee to £5 per team and free for individuals. £770 was taken this year on entry fees.

London Mini Marathon Selection Criteria – 23/04/17

Neil in length discussed the selection for the above event this year. There are 4 selection races which is written in the criteria however this year, it seems that there has been an athlete chosen that has not done all the selected events while there are runners who have been consistent / done all the races and have been put on the reserve list. It was agreed that this event needs to be consistent on athletes and to know at the start of the season what the races are and what is expected from them? They have committed their time to compete in the criteria selection races but some events are confusing as age groups are different. The Welsh Schools officers / selection committee have already been made aware of this and a draft e-mail will be done to express opinions and the way of selecting athletes. A comment agreed was that the November race qualifier can be too early and athletes find their form towards the end of the cross country season. A possibility was to hold a Carmarthenshire Road Relay selection race. Athletes need to know — what are they going to be selecting from — top placings in one or two events or consistent results over 4?

The SIAB qualifier proved to be a good set of races at the Welsh Schools as athletes were aware of what the selection would be this year. The Welsh Schools is normally the final decider ahead of London Mini Marathon selection however this was held a month later than normal this year.
